Key Breakdown of Strengths:

1. Authentic Foundational Logic:

- Collateral form (evaluating relative ability through direct and indirect shared opponents) is an established quantitative and traditional method used by official BHA/Timeform handicappers and bookmaker odds compilers.
- Treating race fields as an interconnected directed graph/network is a mathematically valid application of transitivity principles (similar to PageRank or Elo-based tournament ranking).

2. Nuanced Form Adjustments & Data Decay:

- The tool standardizes beaten lengths by trip distance, adjusts for weight carried, accounts for going/surface conditions, and incorporates time decay (penalizing older collateral lines).
- It explicitly separates high-confidence direct head-to-head evidence (thick lines) from diluted, single-bridge indirect links (thin lines).

3. Responsible Analytical Warnings:
